Open Registration (Accelerated Course)

Course Aim

This is an accelerated course which provides participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to apply for an Open Cablers Registration and to install communications cabling to the requirements of the Australian Communications & Media Authority (ACMA) technical standards.

Duration 40 hours

Course Content

This 5 day accelerated course covers modules:

- NTC004 Regulatory Framework 2—ACA's role and the telecommunications wiring rules.
- NTC014 Basic Telephony—principles and operation of a standard telephone.
- NTC017 Switching Systems Overview—switching system overview and earthing
- NTC111 Telecommunications Cabling Installations—practical wiring and recording skills.
- On successful completion, applicants with the necessary prerequisites will be issued with competency statement ICTTC137A.

Pre-requisites

This is an accelerated course for applicants with trade level experience installing building cabling (Electrical, data, alarms etc) and the background training detailed in the ACMA document "Pathways to ACMA Cabling Provider Rules Cabler Registration" (May 07 edition).

Applicants who are trainees/apprentices or who do not have the relevant industry experience must discuss their situation with an assessor, prior to enrolment to plan a suitable training pathway.

Applicants will need to provide documentary evidence to verify that they meet the pre-requisites:

- * Electrical Principles
- * Occupational Health & Safety/First Aid
- * Hand and Power tool use
- * 600 hours cabling installation experience

*If you are a qualified electrician you will automatically meet all of the entry requirements.

Structure This course will involve theory, practical and assessment.

Students will need the following:

- AS/ACIF S009:2006
- AS/ACIF S008:2006
- Pens/Pencils, coloured highlighters
- Basic hand tools—side cutters, pliers, screwdriver, krone tool

Note: Participants may be eligible for a rebate through the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB). To receive this rebate you must quote a current membership number on your enrolment form and meet CITB funding
