Course Aim

This course aims to provide plumbers with the knowledge and skills to safely carry-out the disconnection, connection and testing to electrical appliances in accordance with the legislation and AS3000:2000.

Duration 16 hours

Course Content

At the end of the course the participant should be able to:

- Interpret installation requirements of AS3000:2007
- Connect, disconnect and reconnect electrical hot water systems
- Identify safe testing procedures
- Carry out self testing to the requirements of AS3000:2007

On successful completion, you will be issued a statement of attainment which you can take to the Office of Consumer & Business Affairs for application of a restricted electrical license.

Pre-requisites

Students must be

- A qualified Plumber
- or*
- A fourth year Apprentice Plumber
